Authors-Meet-Critics Panel

The *Global Labour Journal* (GLJ) invites submissions for an Authors-Meet-Critics panel at the upcoming ISA World Congress of Sociology 2023. The panel will feature recent books (published since January 2020) on any topic in global labor studies. Books published in languages other than English are also welcomed. The organizers will invite critics to engage with each selected book in the panel. After the panel, reviews of the selected books will be published in a section of the GLJ. The deadline for submissions is 7 May 2022. Submissions (by the author or others) should include (1) a full reference for the book (including publisher and year of publication), (2) a short paragraph summarizing the book in English, and (3) an electronic copy of the book for review.
