Letter from the President

Dear RC04 colleagues,

On behalf of the RC04 board I wish all of you a very happy holiday season and a wonderful 2025. In this short address I want to report to you the results of the process by which abstracts were selected for the upcoming V ISA Forum of Sociology (6-11 July, 2025) in Rabat, Morocco.

RC04 as one of the largest RCs in ISA will host 28 sessions and is a co-host in 10 more sessions organized by other RCs or TGs. RC04 session chairs for the 2025 Forum received more than 310 abstracts. The session chairs accepted abstracts that better matched their proposed themes and transferred many to the program chairs (Shaheeda and me). We were able to reallocate a number of abstracts in undersubscribed sessions and to convert two undersubscribed sessions into roundtable sessions which accommodated five individual roundtables each. This permitted us to accept additional abstracts to be included in the RC04 offerings. Thus, we were able to place more than 250 abstracts in the RC04 program. Following ISA guidelines all presentations are expected to be delivered with physical presence. It is essential that individuals whose abstracts have been accepted should register before 22 March, 2025, or else ISA will delete their abstract from the program.

ISA members in good standing, active participants in the program, are eligible to apply for a registration grant. Applications should be sent to Shaheeda (Essack.S@dhet.gov.za) and to me (M.Vryonides@euc.ac.cy) by January 31, 2025. RC04 will also make available a limited number of travel grants. Requests for both types of grants should be sent to us as Program Coordinators by January 31, 2025. I expect that the V ISA Forum of Sociology in Morocco will be an exciting one both academically but also socially giving us an opportunity to meet and socialize in person.
